



CALL FOR POSTERS

Poster Section Overview:

The Poster section offers an excellent opportunity for innovators to present their new technologies, research, and ideas. The poster section is designed as an informal forum for non-vendors to interact with people of similar interests to gain insight, garner support, and promote discussions about their work. The section is intended to expand the conference proceedings to demonstrate how concepts and theories can be used for practical application.

Possible Poster ideas include but are not limited to:

- **KM and PM tools and technologies**
- **Project Management practices**
- **Knowledge Management Practices**
- **Information Security**
- **Information Architectures**
- **Organizational Memory, Archives, and Preservation**
- **Knowledge Management Initiatives**

Poster Selection:

Posters will be selected according to their topic, novelty, and relevance to the conference. All posters should be comprehensive and include all technical detail. They should be visible from a distance of 4 to 6 feet and the actual size of the poster should not exceed one meter in width and one meter in height. The posters should be designed to promote interest and discussions with conference participants.

Poster Materials:

Poster authors are welcome to bring, posters and visual aids, information pamphlets, flyers, and other materials relating to their poster. Poster authors are responsible for the assembly and disassembly of their booths and they are also responsible for the materials throughout the conference. Poster assembly begins on August 18, 2008 prior to the symposium and disassembly will end on August 20, 2008 following the commencement of the symposium. Poster authors must be registered for the conference.

Poster Submission:

All submissions should include an abstract of 150 words or less to describe the poster, and visual aids are recommended but not required. If selected, poster authors will be required to provide a short summary of their poster, including a visual and website information if applicable, to be posted on the conference website. If you wish to submit a poster, please fill out the **Poster Submission Form** and submit it online by **June 30, 2008**.
